THERE ARE 10 MEN BY THE INLAND SEA 14 DAY'S JOURNEY FROM THIS PENINSULA ONE DAY'S JOURNEY NORTH FROM THIS STONE

THE INLAND SEA accurately describes 258-miles long, 60-miles wide, and 9,465 square miles Lake Winnipeg. It is the 5th largest lake in North America.

The Kensington Runestone provides the following mathematical and geographic proof that Lake Winnipeg is **THE INLAND SEA**.

On lines 4 & 5, "**ONE DAY'S JOURNEY NORTH FROM THIS STONE.**"

Not **South**, **East**, or **West** but "**NORTH.**" Lake Winnipeg is directly "**NORTH**" of **FROM THIS STONE** (Runestone Hill). The Expedition was on an overland **JOURNEY** heading straight **South** from **THE INLAND SEA** (Lake Winnipeg) to **FROM THIS STONE** (Runestone Hill).


On lines 10, 11, & 12, "**THERE ARE 10 MEN BY THE INLAND SEA TO LOOK AFTER OUR SHIPS 14 DAY'S JOURNEY FROM THIS PENINSULA**".

A "**DAY'S JOURNEY**" (*Wikipedia: [Day's Journey](#)*) is a historical measurement of distance by walking overland in a day, about **20** to **25 miles**. A **DAY'S JOURNEY** is **20** to **25 miles** x **14 DAY'S** = **280** to **350 miles**. Any internet mapping site shows the distance from Runestone Hill (**FROM THIS PENINSULA**) to the south side of Lake Winnipeg (**THE INLAND SEA**) is **320 miles**. That is in the middle of **280** to **350 miles**. You cannot get much closer than that!

A Day's Journey in pre-modern literature, including the Bible, ancient geographers and ethnographers such as Herodotus, is a measurement of distance.

In the Bible, it is not as precisely defined as other Biblical measurements of distance; the distance has been estimated from 32 to 40 kilometers (**20 to 25 miles**). records a party of three people and two mules who traveled from Bethlehem to Gibeah, a distance of about 10 miles, in an afternoon.
